For what reasons, and with what results, were there so many single-party states in the 20th Century?

• Economy

- High unemployment
- High inflation
- o Reparations (Germany)
- o Debts from WWI
- Strikes

Weak Governments

- o Ineffective governments couldn't deal with economic and political problems going on:
 - Democracies in Germany and Italy
 - Monarchy in Russia
 - Brutal dictators in Batista and Kai-shek
- o Some governments were corrupt or brutal, so people were ready for an alternative
- Paramilitary groups dominated and created violence which the governments couldn't stop

Mistakes

- Provisional government in Russia failed to make reforms and kept them in WWI
- German and Italian leaders thought that Hitler and Mussolini could be controlled or would be mild
- Chiang Kai-shek demilitarized troops and let the Communists gain some of these people; there were many spies in Kai-shek's government
- o Fulgencia Batista granted Fidel and other amnesty to prevent any sour public sentiment

Disillusionment

- Disbelief in the current system
- o People were ready for a change and change is exciting
- o Need for nationalism to restore pride

Ability and personality

- o Most dictators were good orators
- Message appealed to the people
- Used events to manipulate to gain and consolidate power
